Morrison Hershfield Limited has been retained by the Ministry of Transportation to conduct a Preliminary Design and Class Environmental Assessment Study (G.W.P. 3805-01-00) for the long-term strategy of the Argyle Street Bridge that was initiated in 2002.

The long-term strategy study includes: the identification of alternatives for rehabilitation or replacement of the bridge, an environmental assessment and impact study, selection of a preferred alternative for the long-term strategy (rehabilitation or replacement) and development of preliminary construction staging and detour plans.

This study is following the planning process for Group "B" projects in accordance with the Class Environmental Assessment for Provincial Transportation Facilities (2000) with the opportunity for public input throughout the project.
